August 7, 1937 - January 5, 2004

On December 30, 2003 our Lord God called upon Perry Oscar King. His battle with cancer has ended and may he rest in peace. Perry died in the comfort of his own home with his loving wife Karin by his side. Being home, surrounded by his wife, children and friends during his illness was one of his last wishes and was honored. Following graduation Perry enlisted in the U.S. Navy in August of 1955 to serve our country and travel the world. He served as an Airman on the aircraft carrier U.S.S Randolph operating out of Naples, Italy. He was honorably discharged from the Navy on June 1, 1957. Then on August 9, 1958 Perry married the woman he chose to spend the rest of his life with, Karin Hasselstrom. The next 45 years he embraced life with all of the love and vitality a husband, dad, uncle, and grandpa could give each and every day. Perry retired from the banking profession after being Senior

Vice-President of Community First Bank of Glendive and President of Production Credit Association in Glendive. He was a member of the Elks Lodge and a volunteer of numerous youth organizations over the years. He will be fondly remembered for his zest for life, hard work, compassion for all of mankind, and love of the outdoors. He will be missed but is now serving God in a brand new capacity. Perry is survived by his wife, Karin King of Glendive; his children, Susan King of Spokane, Washington and Steven (Nancy) King of Reno, Nevada; three grandchildren, Austin King, Kaitlin King, and Nathan King; two brothers, George Holom of Miles City, Montana and Duane Holom of Townsend, Montana; a sister, Darlene Hochhalter of Coeur D Alene, Idaho; and numerous relatives.
