August 13, 1922 - September 6, 2003

Phillip T. Cook Jr, age 81, of Sentinel Butte, North Dakota, died at the Fallon County Medical Center in Baker, Montana on Monday, September 1, 2003. A Vigil will be held at 7:00 P.M., Friday, September 5, 2003 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:00 A.M., Saturday, September 6, 2003 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva, North Dakota with Reverend Father David Richter officiating. Rite of Committal will be in St. Michael's Cemetery in Sentinel Butte. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Beach is entrusted with arrangements. Phillip was born in Sentinel Butte on August 13, 1922 the son of Phillip Taylor Sr. and Evelyn (Northrop) Cook. He was educated at Westerheim School and graduated from Sentinel Butte High School. Following high school, he worked for the Civilian Conservation Corp for three years. He moved to Alaska and worked on the Alaskan highway for two years. Phill returned to Sentinel Butte in 1943 and on April 18, 1944 he married Mary Zinsli at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Sentinel Butte. After their marriage the moved to Saco, Montana and worked in an elevator for one year returning to Golden Valley County, North Dakota and worked at the Thelen elevator for one and one half years. He drove the ice cream truck in Glendive, Montana for Purity Dairies for five years, a gasoline transport for two years. He moved to Marion, Iowa and drove a freight truck until retiring in 1981 and returning to Sentinel Butte where he resided until the time of his death. Phill was preceded in death by his parents and one brother Joe. He is survived by his wife Mary of Sentinel Butte; for sons, Leo and his wife Maggie
