Ralph Paul Begger, age 83, of Wibaux MT passed away Monday May 10, 2021. A Vigil service will be held at 6:00 PM on Thursday, June 3, 2021 at St. Peters Catholic Church in Wibaux. Mass of christian burial will be at 10:30 AM on Friday, June 4, 2021 at St. Peters Catholic Church in Wibaux with Father Baskar Anandan officiating. Ralph was born October 8, 1937 to John and Helen (Watembach) Begger in Beach, ND. He attended South Center School and graduated from Wibaux County High School in 1955. He was raised on the family farm where he continued to farm and ranch until his death.

Ralph entered the Army Reserves in December of 1955 and was stationed in Fort Bliss, TX. He was Honorably Discharged in 1963.
