Ralph M. Boehm, age 76, of Glendive, passed away on Wednesday, January 29, 2003 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Monday, February 3, 2003 at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Pastor Robert Canen officiating. Ralph was born on March 25, 1926 in Mandan, North Dakota, the son of Ralph and Veronica (Schmidt) Boehm. He lived with his family in Mandan until moving to Glendive at a young age. Following his discharge in February of 1947, Ralph returned to Glendive where he worked as a machinist for the Northern Pacific Railroad, Montana Dakota Utilities and the Glendive School District. Ralph enjoyed fishing, agate hunting and attending ball games. He was preceded in death by his parents; and one brother, Donny.
