



Ralph Franklin Miller

June 10, 1922 - December 6, 2008

GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Ralph Franklin Miller, 86, died on December 2, 2008 at his home in Glendive. Visitation will be held on Friday, December 5, 2008, from 9:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held on Saturday, December 6, 2008 at 10:00 A.M. at Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. Interment with military honors will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Ralph was born on June 10, 1922 in Glendive, the son of Soren Johan and Ruth Alice (Henderson) Miller. He was raised in the Savage, Montana and Intake, Montana area, receiving his early education at the Beef Slough School near Savage and he attended high school at the Savage High School in Savage and Dawson County High School in Glendive. Ralph moved to Glendive in 1936 where he was employed by Hood Construction, the Northern Pacific Railroad on an extra gang and the Bismark Grocery. Ralph entered the United States Army in 1942 serving during World War II. Ralph received an honorable discharge from military service in 1946. He Married Myra Lorvetta Harvey on January 18, 1948 in Terry, Montana and they farmed and ranched on the Harvey Ranch near Lindsay, Montana from 1956 until their retirement. Ralph was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1125 and had served as Post Commander, he was a 40 year member of the Glendive Moose Lodge #949, a 25 year member of the Glendive Elks Lodge #1324 and

35 year member of the American Legion of Glendive. Ralph had served on the Deer Creek Church Board as a Trustee, on the United States Department of Agriculture Community Committee and on the Board of Directors of the Farmers Union Oil Station of Lindsay. Ralph was preceded in death by his wife Lorvetta on April 27, 2000, one son; George "Jug" Miller and one brother, Wayne Miller. Survivors include one daughter; Wendy Labrie of Billings, Montana, two brothers; Wendell and his wife Ruth Miller of Janesville, New York, Dean and his wife Virginia Miller of Billings, 2 grandchildren; Lacie Labrie of Billings, Todd Labrie and his wife Sonja of Lindsay, Montana, two great grandchildren, one sister in-law, Marinette Weeden of Billings and numerous nieces and nephews.
