Randolph "Randy" G. Urbanec, age 75 of Glendive, Montana passed away at his home on Saturday, September 30, 2017. Randy enjoyed golfing, boating, and spending time at his cabin at Fort Peck. He also enjoyed anything that had to do with his businesses. His real passion, however, were his son and his 3 grandchildren, whom he loved and spent as much time with as possible.

Randy was preceded in death by his father George; and his sister Sherry Anne Urbanec.
