To this union, eight children were born: Eugene, Clel, Diana, Patty, Ray, Mike, Bruce and Broderick. They resided in Glendive until 1955 when they moved to Glasgow. Ray married Thelma Kampf on January 21, 1966 in Havre. They resided in Havre until Thelma passed away in 2005 and Ray spent four months with his son, Mike until moving to Orange Park, Florida to be with his daughter, Diana. Ray enjoyed fishing, hunting and playing cards - especially Pitch. Ray is preceded in death by his parents; his wife of 39 years,

Thelma; sons, Eugene and Broderick; five sisters, Margaret, Blanche Olivera, Carol, Bernice Rathbun and Virginia Reinholz; three brothers, Leslie, Howard and Glen.
