GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Raymond "Ray" John Marman, age 79, passed away on Sunday, August 15, 2010 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. He attended grades 1 through 8 in Beach, North Dakota, and Freshman and Sophomore years at Dawson County High School before graduating from Beach High School with the class of 1948. Ray entered the United States Navy in February 1949, during his time in the service he was stationed in Korea during the Korean War. Ray was honorably discharged from the Navy in February 1953. Ray married Mary Ann Barthel on June 19, 1954 in St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux, Montana. Ray worked most of his career in the oilfield where he worked for Hi-Ball Trucking, Western Oil Service, Alaska Pipeline and Williston-Basin Pipeline. He was also employed by the U.S. Postal Service. Ray was a member the Glendive Moose Lodge

#949, the Veteran's of Foreign Wars Post 1125 and was a former post commander. Ray was preceded in death by his parents, one daughter, Nancy Bollinger. Survivors include his wife Mary Ann Marman of Glendive; four sons, Joseph of Auburn, California, Gary (Connie) of Billings, Montana, Roger (Kim) of Powell, Wyoming and Brad of Bismarck, North Dakota; one daughter, Sue Marman of Boise, Idaho; eight grandchildren, Sarah, Mary, Adam, Leighton, Brielle, Elliott, Alexis Marman and Brittany Bollinger; one brother, Charles Marman of Glendive; two sisters, Lorrita (Larry) Garriott and Pat Branum and numerous nieces and nephews.
