



## Raymond Van Scoik

December 22, 1914 - July 29, 2005

Raymond E. Van Scoik, age 90, of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, July 24, 2005 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Friday, July 29, 2005 at the Breakforth Bible Church in Glendive with Pastor Larry Phalen officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Ray was born on December 22, 1914 in Chicago, Illinois, the son of Raymond H. and Mabel Marie (Iseminger) Van Scoik. He was raised and educated in Hobart, Indiana. He left school in his senior year to take care of his grandmother following the death of his grandfather. He was united in marriage to Elsie Marie Copeland on February 16, 1942 in Kewanna, Indiana. Ray worked as a short order cook, at the Studebaker Factory and at Pullman Railroad car plants. He took care of horses at the Culver Military Academy in Culver, Indiana and worked at a munitions plant after his discharge from the military in 1943. Ray had worked as the maintenance engineer for various business in Illinois and Indiana until he and his wife moved to Glendive in 1973. Ray was employed by the Holiday Lodge in Glendive until he officially retired in 1979. He continued to work as many hours a month as he could until he was 75 years old. Ray's hobbies included fishing, gardening and he was an avid Chicago Cub's fan. He was preceded in death by his wife Elsie in 1993; two brothers, Wil and Robert and a grandson, Christopher Lundgren. Survivors include his sons, Richard Van Scoik Sr. and his wife Elizabeth and Raymond Van Scoik,

all of Glendive; daughters, Claudia Morin and her husband Daniel and Linda Lundgren and her husband Richard, all of Glendive; three brothers, Claude Van Scoik and his wife Ella of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, James Van Scoik and his wife Pat of Glendive, and Daniel Van Scoik of Sun City, Arizona; 14 grandchildren and 25 great grandchildren.
