Raymond Vegele, age 63, of Glendive, went to his heavenly home on Tuesday evening, April 3, 2007 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Friday, April 6, 2007 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Raymond was born on his mother's birthday, April 9, 1943 in Glendive, Montana, the son of Emil and Caroline (Kaul) Vegele. He was baptized at the Marsh Lutheran Church and confirmed at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive on May 5, 1957. He graduated from Dawson County High School with the class of 1963. He then attended Dawson Community College, graduating in 1965. Raymond attended Western Montana College at Dillon and Dickinson State Teacher's College. Raymond was a clerk, city park employee and a teacher. He enlisted in the United States Army on June 18, 1968 and was honorably discharged in December of 1968. He received the National Defense Service Medal and Marksman Badge. Raymond lived in the Sheridan and Ranchester, Wyoming areas for the past 24 years until September 2006 when he returned to Glendive. His favorite past time was playing his accordion - especially polkas, waltzes and other music. He also enjoyed hunting and fishing. Raymond was preceded in death by his parents. Survivors include his sister, Edna Boyce and her husband David of Glendive; his nephew, Tom Boyce and his wife Tracy of Billings; two nieces, Ellen Jandt and her husband Scott of New York
