



## Richard Bushman

February 15, 1923 - January 27, 2004

Richard C. Bushman, age 80, of Wibaux, Montana, died at his home on Saturday, January 24, 2004. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 1:00 P.M., Tuesday, January 27, 2004 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux with Reverend Denis Fournier OSB officiating. Rite of Committal with military graveside rites will follow services at the Wibaux Cemetery. A Vigil will be held at 7:00 P.M., Monday, January 26, 2004 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Wibaux is entrusted with arrangements. Richard was born February 15, 1923 in the old Wibaux Hospital at Wibaux, Montana the son of Marvin and Phylis (Erickson) Bushman. He attended country schools through the eighth grade and Wibaux High School graduating with the class of 1941. Richard was married to Dorothy Morgen at Wibaux, Montana on March 6, 1945. Richard served in the U.S. Army in the 168 Infantry in the European Theater of war for three years. After the war ended in Europe he trained on the Flame Thrower for the war in the Pacific. Before he went to the Pacific the war there ended and he was discharged. Richard owned and operated the Super Valu Store in Wibaux from 1946 to 1978. He sold the store in 1978 and worked for Rahr's Meat Packing in Glendive for one and a half years. He went back to work for Ernest Super Valu in Wibaux for four years before retiring. Richard was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux, a lifetime member of Knights of Columbus, lifetime member of the V.F.W. where he was post commander and a member of the American Legion. He was chairman for the Red Cross for

four years, served on the City Council for 16 years, and was a lifetime member of the Saddle Club. Richard was a very devoted husband, father and grandfather. He enjoyed hunting and was a big fan at the Wibaux football and basketball games. Richard was preceded in death by his parents; one infant son, Richard and one brother Bill. Richard is survived by his wife Dorothy of Wibaux, Montana; two daughters, Linda Gaalswyk and her husband Larry and Kathryn Anderson and her husband Lew, all of Billings; one son, Robert Bushman and his wife Judy of Wibaux; one brother, Jon Bushman and his wife Norma of Park City, Montana; 13 grandchildren and numerous nephews and nieces.
