



## Richard "Dick" Raden

June 30, 1945 - March 27, 2018

On Tuesday, March 27th, 2018 Richard "Dick" Raden, age 72 left us to be with the love of his life, Hazel. Visitation will be held from 10:00 A.M. until 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, April 4, 2018 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive, Montana. Funeral services will be at 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, April 4, 2018 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Reverend Avis Anderson officiating. Interment with military honors will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. A celebration of Dick's life will also be held in Martinsdale, Montana at a later date. Dick was born on June 30th, 1945 in Washington, D.C. to Frances (Bud) & Dorothy (Molland) Raden. He was the second oldest of six children and the oldest son. The family moved to North Dakota for a few years before settling in Glendive. Glendive is where he met the love of his life Hazel. Dick and Hazel knew each other from an early age, and as rumor has it, he was known to chase Hazel home from school. Dick enlisted in the United States Navy on September 27th, 1966. Before shipping out for Vietnam, Dick and Hazel were married in Coeur D'Alene, Idaho on January 19th, 1968. After his return he was given an Honorable discharge from the Navy on March 5th, 1969. They lived in Federal Way, Washington where he was employed making cabinets. In 1972 they decided to move back to Montana and settled in Billings. Dick worked for many years in all aspects of construction before going to work for Keebler where family and friends referred to him as the "Cookie Man". He was

an avid sportsman loving to hunt and fish with family and friends especially when the “Brothers” would get together. Many vacations in the summer were taken on their motorcycle going anywhere from Sturgis, South Dakota or Sekiu, Washington to go fishing. Hazel passed away in 1999. Dick then spent a few years driving truck for Idaho Asphalt. In June of 2005 Dick moved from Billings to Martinsdale. There he did many hauling jobs waiting for hunting season.

Dick is survived by his daughters Theresa & Jennifer, his son-in-law Mike, grandchildren Mikayla and Michael, sisters Donna (Med) Eastwood, Diane Trescott, brothers Dennis (Donna) Raden, Doug (Brenda) Raden, Jim (Deb) Raden, along with numerous nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 31 years, Hazel, son Mark, parents Bud & Dorothy Raden, in-laws Gordon & Pearl Russell and brother-in-law Gary Trescott.
