Richard resided in Glendive until the time of his death. Richard worked as a mechanic for a total of 30 years working at the Chevy Garage in Circle and at several farms in the Circle Area. He also worked as a janitor at Circle High School. After moving to Glendive Richard continued his janitorial work at the Dawson County Library and

Dawson County Court House. After retirement Richard enjoyed volunteering at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care and at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home. Richard's hobbies included his life's work of mechanics, taking walks with his wife and volunteering as well as camping with the kids. He loved his grandchildren. Richard was willing to do any honest work in order to support his family. Richard was preceded in death by his parents and his daughter, Patty Honeymann.
