As a teenager and young adult Bob worked at the Anaconda Copper Smelter until he met Chris Real to whom he married in 1978 then later remarried in 2003. Bob had two children during his marriage to Chris his son Jordan in 1979 then Kellie his daughter in 1981. After his first marriage to Chris ended Bob moved to Glendive. While in Glendive Bob was a loyal and very decorated Jaycees member until he retired as a Jaycee Senator. Bob was a kind and loyal husband and father with a heart larger than life always willing to help family and friends in need. He worked for the Montana Department of Transportation as a road inspector for twenty years. Bob's health deteriorated with his diagnosis of Diabetes which in turn forced him to retire from the MDT.

Bob knew and loved classic cars especially the hard top convertible 1966 Chevy Corvette he had during his first marriage to Chris. Bob loved to work on cars and trucks until he was unable to do so because of his health. Bob was also an old car guru, you could be sitting in a restaurant and see an older car then ask him what it was and he would not only tell you what it was but how he knew it was that year, model, and even options for that model of car. Bob always tried to help anyone in need even when he himself needed help even more. Everyone who knew Bob was always cheered up with his broken smile and humor. Bob was always in a good mood and had a caring heart that was

unequaled by anyone. Bob in retirement worked at the Vets home for a while as a food service worker always trying to cheer up his coworkers & patients with his laughter. Even after Bob fully retired he always tried to play and give attention to his grandchildren even though his health limited his mobility. Bob died in his son's arms on December 13, 2014 on his way into the ER at the Glendive Medical Center.
