



Robert J. Frederickson

January 29, 1909 - May 8, 2004

Robert J. Frederickson, age 95, of Glendive, passed away on Monday, May 3, 2004 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Saturday, May 8, 2004 at the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Glendive with Brother Guy Pontoriero officiating. Interment with military honors will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Robert was born on January 29, 1909 in Savage, Montana the son of August and Margaret (Hunter) Frederickson. He was raised and educated in Savage. Bob entered the U.S. Army on April 23, 1942 and served during World War II. He was honorable discharged on October 29, 1945. He married Bernadette "Bernie" Goedert on April 7, 1947 in Fairview, Montana. They made their home in Savage until 1951 when they moved to Glendive. She preceded him in death on February 24, 1967. He married Maggie Midboe Groll on December 19, 1969 in Glendive. Bob worked for the Glendive Water Plant for 21 years before retiring and joining RSVP. He was selected as RSVP Volunteer of the Year in 1991. He was an active member of the 55+ Club, Montana Senior Citizens Association, and County Council on Aging. He served on the Board of Directors for 55+ and was Vice President of County Council on Aging. For many years, he ran the addressograph for the RSVP office, addressing the newsletter monthly. He addressed newsletters for RSVP, Dawson Community College, VFW and Chamber of Commerce. Bob served on the museum board and worked at the museum whenever needed.

He helped with displays, woodworking and yard maintenance. Another big project is the Food Bank where Bob worked every Tuesday, until just recently, sorting out food that has been donated and stocking shelves. He was active in the First Congregational United Church of Christ, Cancer Society and helped the county extension office with bicycle safety training. Everything important in Bob's life was geared toward helping others. He was preceded in death by his parents; one brother, Alfred and two sisters, Marjory and Marguerite. Survivors include his wife, Maggie, of Glendive; one sister, Anna Marie Johnson of Colorado; numerous nieces and nephews.
