

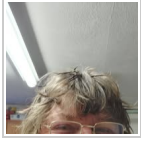


Robert Martinez

February 23, 1950 - July 6, 2004

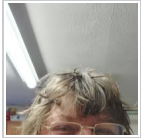
Robert Joseph Martinez, age 54, of Glendive, formerly of Forsyth and Billings, Montana, died on Wednesday, June 30, 2004 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 A.M., Tuesday, July 6, 2004 at the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Forsyth, Montana with Father Gary Norman officiating.
