Robert (Bob) Polivka died Sunday, August 20, 2006 at St. David's South Austin Hospital after a long struggle with diabetes. A memorial service was held on Thursday, August 31, 2006 at 6:30 p.m., at the First Baptist Church of Oak Hill in Austin, Texas with Pastor Ray Knowles officiating. Graveside services with military honors will be held at 11:30 A.M., Thursday, September 14, 2006 in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive, Montana with Pastor T.C. Chatman officiating.
