His parents, Robert and Reanna, were overwhelmed with love, excitement, and pride with this sweet, innocent life that joined their lives. Two weeks early from his expected due date, Robbie weighed 5 lbs. 4 oz and was 19" long. The doctors placed Robbie on Reanna's chest, something not done when her

daughter had been born, and for Reanna, it was a feeling like no other, bonding with her new son as he lay with her. For Robert, Robbie's birth was his first experience in the delivery room, and as the nurses took Robbie from his mother, to weigh, measure, and run standard newborn baby tests, Robert's arms ached to hold his son. Robert followed those nurses around watching and questioning their every move until finally Robbie was placed in his arms. What a joyful moment! Robert describes his son with pride, proclaiming Robbie looked "so damned cute, just like his father. " Robbie's hair was blonde, and he was blessed with his mother's toes, one toe on each foot being noticeably longer than all the others, and Robbie's nose resembled that of his grandmother Linda. His dad's voice expressed wonder at how soft Robbie's skin was. Robbie was all boy and perfect. But even before Robbie's birth, his parents wanted and loved this child. Robert and Reanna had decided to let nature take its course and leave it in God's hands when to have their next child. It took about a year for Reanna to become pregnant. If the baby was a girl, Robert would choose the name, and if the baby was a boy, Reanna would choose. Robert's choice of names for a daughter was Angel Rein, and Reanna's choice for a son was Robert. During the pregnancy, the baby's ultra sounds showed a boy. Robert tried to convince Reanna to name him Angel but Reanna was firm about the name Robert, and the middle name Ray was dad's input, named after his dad. Robert Ray Brammer... they liked the ring that name had to it.
