



## Robert "Bob" Rudnick

November 7, 1933 - February 9, 2012

Glendive, Montana: Robert "Bob" Rudnick, age 78, passed away on February 4, 2012 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. A Memorial Service will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, February 9, 2012 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Bob was born on November 7, 1933 in Jamestown, North Dakota the son of Max and Margaret (Powell) Rudnick. He received his education in Jamestown schools and enlisted in the United State Army on November 24, 1954 and was stationed in Germany. They made their home in Jamestown where Bob was employed by Farmers Union Oil as a mechanic. Following his retirement he was employed part time transporting automobiles for American Ford and Glendive Sales in Glendive. Bob was a member of the Glendive Elks Lodge #1324. His hobbies included fishing, camping and traveling with friends and family. He also enjoyed being able to watch all of his grandson's sporting events. Bob was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers, Lewis and Ralph.
