Robert L. Schneider (Bob), age 92 of Glendive, Montana, formerly of Colorado Springs, Colorado, passed away on Saturday, November 12, 2022 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Cremation has taken place and no local services will be held at this time. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Bob was born and raised on his family's fruit orchard in Hart, Michigan. Upon graduating from High School, he joined the U.S. Navy where he served during the Korean War on the USS Watts DD567 from 1952 – 1956. Shortly after serving in the military, he moved to the Upper Peninsula of Michigan with his first wife, Jeanette where they owned the Silver Dollar Bar as well as the Dollarville Canoe & Boat Rental Shop. At this time, he was also one of the first Dive Certified Search & Rescue members in Michigan.

In 1976, he sold his businesses and left the State of Michigan to pursue a career as a Millwright. This allowed him to travel around the country where he installed large equipment and machinery. The last big project in his career (prior to retiring) was installing the conveyor belt at the Denver Airport. Upon retiring, he and his wife Mabel of 40 years continued their love of antiquing by traveling to flea markets and estate sales, as well as running an antique shop in Colorado Springs, Colorado. He and his wife also enjoyed prospecting, panning for Gold and such. He also had a love for the great outdoors, was an avid hunter and fisherman (and was once a competitive snowmobile racer). He is preceded in death by his parents George & Olive Schneider, his sister

Marilyn Shumaker and his wife Marilyn Longcore Schneider.

He is survived by his 5 children, 20 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren.

His children include his son Robert Schneider with wife Trudy (children include Brian, Cody, Kyle, Samantha and Jacquie), his son Michael Schneider (children include Eric, Michael, Victoria, Christopher, Josh), his son John Schneider with his wife Karen (children include Aaron, Seth, Alexa and Gideon), his son James Schneider (children include Josh, Shelby and Whitney) and his daughter Lisa Swanson with her husband Scott (children include Samantha, Jena and Buzz).
