



## Robert Arthur Webb

January 30, 1942 - October 15, 2025

Robert Webb, 83, passed away October 15, 2025, at St Vincent's Hospital in Billings, MT after a long illness.

Robert began his career with the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) in 1959 at Zortman, Montana. His first major assignment was on the highway project stretching south from Zortman to the Fred Robinson Bridge. Over the following decades, Robert contributed to many essential highway projects across Northeastern Montana. In 1979, his dedication led him to Glendive, where he was promoted to Maintenance Chief for the Glendive Maintenance Division. He served in this leadership role until his retirement from MDT in 1993. After his retirement from the MDT, Robert spent several years working for Kron Construction.

He found his most cherished role: driving a school bus for the Glendive School District. Robert often claimed this was the "easiest and most fun job of all." He always commented how all of the younger kids would bring him cookies and candy at Christmas. He happily transported students until the end of the school year in 2024.

He later moved to Billings due to declining health.

Robert was an active part of the Glendive Elks Club and was honored as Elk

of the Year in 1990.

Robert was preceded in death by his parents, Sherman and Ida Webb, his brothers, James, John, Charles, Sam and baby Lucius. He is survived by his sisters: Marie Robertson, Magdalena Webb, Deloris (Jim) Marriage, Rose Anne Watts, Patti (John) Wilke and his brother, Sherman, Jr., (Brenda) and many cherished cousins, nieces and nephews, including special niece Lori "Vera" Webb Knudsen.
