Roland Brown, age 86, passed away on Wednesday, December 16, 2020 at the Fallon County Medical Complex in Baker, Montana. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 23, 2020 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive, Montana with Reverend Brenda Frelsi officiating. Interment will follow in Sentinel Butte Cemetery in Sentinel Butte, North Dakota. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Roland Reese Brown was the second born of eleven children to Will F. and Cora M. (Johnstone) Brown on September 20, 1934 in Sentinel Butte, North Dakota. The family was raised on the farm North of Sentinel Butte. Roland graduated in 1952 and was drafted into the U.S. Army in 1954, serving in Korea and Germany until 1956. He was decorated with an Army of Occupation Medal (Germany), Expert Sub-Machine Gun, Good Conduct Medal, Marksman (M-1 Rifle), and Marksman (Carbine).

Roland met and married Virginia Otreмба on October 3, 1956 in Fresno, California. To this union five children were born: Kathy, Bruce, Leona, Ricky, and Terry. They lived in various towns in Mideastern Montana until settling in Glendive in 1965. Roland was a carpenter and cement finisher until his retirement in the late 90's. He could name every bridge and creek in Eastern Montana. He took pride in his work and taught his sons and grandsons his trade. One of his last projects was the seating for Dawson County High School's stadium seating.

In 1984 Roland became a single parent to Terry, age 13, when Virginia passed

away from breast cancer. He was a good provider and had many skills he passed on to family. From hunting, fishing, cooking, canning jam, and lefse making, and the list goes on. Playing pinocle and doing zig zaw puzzles helped pass the time. Along with coffee with his Vet friends and time spent at the VFW. Helping with the U.S. Flag during the holidays was important to him. Roland will be dearly missed by his family.
