



## Ronald Dale "Ronnie" Kaufman

April 8, 1936 - July 21, 2011

Glendive, Montana: Ronald Dale "Ronnie" Kaufman, age 75, passed away Sunday, July 17, 2011 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Visitation will be held from 9:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Wednesday, July 20, 2011 at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, July 21, 2011 at the Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Interment with military honors will be held in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Ronnie was born on April 8, 1936 in Armour, South Dakota, the son of Arnold and Minnie (Teske) Kaufman. At the age of ten, he moved to Glendive with his parents where he received his education and attended the Dawson County High School. Ronnie enlisted in the United States Marine Corp on March 17, 1956 and served until March 16, 1958 when he was honorably discharged. He returned to Glendive where he was employed by Montana Dakota Utilities at the power plant until 1968 when he moved to the Corrosion Department of Williston Basin Interstate Pipeline where he remained until his retirement in 1998. Ronnie married Linda Hoiland on November 26, 1966 in Glendive where they made their home since that time. Ronnie was a member of the Glendive Elks Lodge # 1324, Walleye's Unlimited and the Glendive Trap Club. He enjoyed fishing, woodworking and he especially enjoyed trapshooting. Ronnie had earned first place honors at the Montana State Big Sky Games three times and had also placed second

and third at these games several times. Ronnie was preceded in death by his parents, and two brothers, Arnold Jr. and Ivan. Survivors include his wife, Linda of Glendive; daughter Debi (Tim) Lytle of Glendive, two sons, Troy (Erin) Kaufman of Glendive and Paul (Tami) Kaufman of Lewistown, Montana; eight grandchildren, BreAnn, Travis, Kendra, Brittany, Milo, Otto, Jason and Emily Ruth; and one brother, Al (Arlene) Kaufman of Glendive.
