GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Roy Walter Grebeldinger, age 81, passed away on Monday, May 18, 2009 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Roy was born on October 25, 1927, the son of John J. and Rosella (Haegle) Grebeldinger in Glendive. Roy remained with the railroad until his retirement as Assistant Foreman for the car shop in 1987. He married Emma Gaub on May 26, 1951 in Miles City, Montana and they made their home in Glendive. Roy enjoyed automobiles and took great pride in having completely restored a 1931 Willy's during his retirement years. He also enjoyed gardening, hunting, fishing and walking his dogs. Roy always enjoyed farm life and helping with all activities on the family farm near Terry, Montana. Roy was preceded in death by his parents; his wife Emma in 2006; one brother, Donald Grebeldinger; two of his favorite uncles, Garfield Trulock and Tony Haegle. Survivors include two daughters, Kathy Broeder and her husband Warren of Glendive, Sue Grebeldinger of Advance, North Carolina;
