Billings, Montana: Roy Alexander McCaskey, age 98, of Billings, formerly of Beach, North Dakota passed away on Tuesday, June 7, 2011 at the Billings Health and Rehabilitation Center in Billings. Visitation will be held from 9:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. on Friday, June 10, 2011 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Beach. Roy was born on November 17, 1912 in Elmwood Township in Golden Valley County, North Dakota, the son of Roy Alexander and Anna Elizabeth (Jerschele) McCaskey. While growing up Roy attended the Bonnie View School in Elmwood Township and completed the course requirements in 1927. Roy joined the United States Army on April 30, 1941 at Fort Snelling, Minnesota. Roy served in World War II as a PFC with the 9201 Technical Service Unit/Transportation Corps. He served in combat with the 1st Marine Division, Reinforced, on Guadalcanal. Roy served honorably in the military until separated on November 2, 1945 at Fort Dix, New Jersey. After separation from the military, Roy made his living by farming and working as a field man for the United States Department of Agriculture. Roy was a life member of the Knights of Columbus and the American Legion. In 1978, Roy retired and

moved to Billings where he resided until the time of his death. Roy is preceded in death by his parents; one sister, Mary Strzywski; and five brothers, Alex, John, Joe, James (Pat) and Engelbert. Roy is survived by a sister, Cecelia Christian of Pueblo, Colorado and all of his nieces and nephews.
