



## Roy G. Smith

July 28, 1931 - July 31, 2014

Roy G. Smith, age 83, of Glendive, Montana, formerly of Terry, Montana, passed away on Thursday, July 31, 2014 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. A Memorial Service will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Monday, August 4, 2014 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Interment with military honors will be held at 11:30 A.M. in the Prairie County Cemetery in Terry, Montana. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Roy was born on July 28, 1931 at the family home near Trotters, North Dakota, he was the son of Arthur C. Smith and Alice (Terry) Smith. Shortly after Roy's birth the family moved to his mothers homestead near Savage, Montana where Roy was raised and educated through his sophomore year in high school when he enlisted in the United States Army. Roy served in the United States Army for three and a half years serving in the Korean War where he was wounded and received the Purple Heart Award. He was honorably discharged in June of 1952. Following his honorable discharge from military service, Roy moved to Glendive where he met and later married Marjorie Devier on July 26, 1952 and to this union two children were born. Roy worked several different jobs supporting his family before buying his own business. He purchased Terry Ford in 1971 which he owned and operated until 1993 when he retired. Roy enjoyed hunting, fishing, gardening and providing for his family was always his first priority. He loved spending time with his family and friends. He was a member of Hospital Board in Terry and

the Terry Chamber. He was an ambulance driver and a volunteer Fireman. Roy was preceded in death by his parents; wife; two brothers, Clarence and Ben Smith and one sister, Flossie Watson.

He is survived by his daughter, Jeannine (Jere) Freiboth of Terry, and son, Stuart Smith of Miles City, Montana; five grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; two sisters, Gladys Lye of Terry and Jean Merchan of South Dakota and numerous nieces and nephews.
