In 1937 Ruby came to Medora and worked at the Cave Restaurant, and while in Medora she met Lester Tisor and they were later married on April 4, 1939. Ruby worked at the United States Post Office in Medora, the Auditor and Treasurers Office in Billings County Courthouse and in 1954 she was employed by the Farmers Home Administration until she retired in 1978. Ruby was also a Managing Editor for the Billings County Pioneer for eight years, Treasurer of DeMores School

Board for eleven years and Secretary of the Golden Valley Manor Board for seventeen years. Ruby was preceded in death by her parents; two sisters, Beatrice and Margret Lingk; one brother, Vernon Walters; one granddaughter, Tracy Klusmann and one son-in-law, Kenny Hoger.
