



## Ruth Mullet

October 8, 1925 - October 29, 2019

Ruth (Nissley) Mullet passed away on October 23rd in Great Falls, MT at the age of 94. A memorial service was held on November 2nd at the Redtop Church in Bloomfield, Montana, with pastors Joe Young, Tanner Ripley and Jeff Warix officiating,

Ruth was born on October 8th, 1925, the youngest child of seven born to Daniel and Lydia (Yoder) Nissley of Bloomfield, MT. Ruth and her future husband, Ernest Mullet, both grew up in the Bloomfield community. No matter where life would take them, this community would always be home.
