



## Ruthyn "Rudy" Mohl

BILLINGS, MONTANA: Ruthyn "Rudy" Erwin Mohl, age 68, of Glendive, Montana passed away on Sunday, May 2, 2010 at the Billings Health and Rehabilitation Center in Billings. Visitation will be held from 10:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Thursday, May 6, 2010 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Friday, May 7, 2010 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Interment with military honors will be held in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Ruthyn was born on September 11, 1941 in Krem, North Dakota to Erwin and Elsie (Wolf) Mohl. He received his early education at parochial school in Pick City, North Dakota and graduated from Riverdale High School in Riverdale, North Dakota. After graduation Ruthyn entered the United States Army and served for two years. Upon his honorable discharge from military service he returned to North Dakota and attended Wahpeton College receiving his degree in auto mechanics. After college Ruthyn moved to Glendive and worked for many years as a mechanic for Urbanec Motors, Brengles and HKT Big Sky Motors. He later worked for Western Oil Well Service before going to work at Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad (BNSF), he retired from BNSF in 2007. After retirement he started J.R. Tree Service with his grandson Jay Kutzler. Ruthyn was a member of the Elks and the Moose. He was a volunteer for the West Glendive Fire Department, retiring after 33 years of service.

Ruthyn married Gladys Kutzler on April 18, 1970 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive. Gladys and Ruthyn enjoyed many years together hunting and fishing. They kept each other company gardening and doing yard work. In his later years Ruthyn especially enjoyed his "toy" John Deere tractors. He was an excellent woodworker, and had built much of the furniture and cabinets for his home. He also enjoyed making several kinds of wines and sharing them with his family and friends. Ruthyn was preceded in death by his parents, a brother Leon, his wife Gladys in January 2010, brother-in-law Marvin Vaagen, two step sons; Duane and Fred Kutzler. Survivors include his sister Mardella Vaagen, niece Deeon Bickle both of Miles City, Montana, nephew Paul Vaagen of Warner-Robins, Georgia, great nephews, step son Ken Kutzler and his wife Yvonne, daughter-in-law Mary Kutzler all of Glendive, 6 grandchildren; DeEtte Thoen, TJ Kutzler, Jay Kutzler, Loren Kutzler, Paul Kutzler and Polly Davis, 12 great grandchildren.
