



S. Keith Warrenburg

April 19, 1935 - November 20, 2015

Stanley "Keith" Warrenburg, age 80, formerly of Glendive, Montana passed away on Friday, November 20, 2015 at the Sacred Heart Medical Center in Spokane, Washington. Visitation will be held from 1:00 P.M. until 2:00 P.M. on Saturday, November 28, 2015 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive. Funeral Services will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Saturday, November 28, 2015 at Our Savior Lutheran Church with Pastor Greg Lucido officiating. Keith was born on April 19, 1935 in Dwight, Kansas, a son of Benjamin and Dorothy (Madison) Warrenburg. He was raised and educated in Colorado Springs, Colorado, graduating high school from Colorado Springs High School with the class of 1953. Following his high school education Keith attended college at Colorado College where he received his Bachelor's Degree in Banking and Financing. He was later drafted into the United States Army on April 14, 1958 and was honorably discharged on January 18, 1960.

After returning home Keith met and later married Alyce Darlene Buxbaum on December 30, 1963 and to their union two children were born. After working for Texaco as a Landman for five years, together they moved to Glendive in 1969 and raised their family. Keith began his career in banking at 1st Security Bank in Glendive, Montana where he had worked for over twenty years.

Following that he had worked for First National Bank of Wibaux and then later for Houck Energy as a Landman before retiring in 2009.

Keith had numerous hobbies including fishing, collecting and finishing agates, wood working, coin collecting, photography, golf, playing cards, camping, traveling, gourmet club dinners and square dancing with Alyce. Keith mostly enjoyed spending time and visiting with his family and friends.

Keith was active in many organizations over the years including Lions Club as past District President, Elks Club, Moose Lodge, Red Devil Booster Club, Makoshika Swingers and most recently joined the Rock and Rollers in Spokane Valley, Washington. He also helped coach many years of Little League and Babe Ruth Baseball.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Benjamin and Dorothy; and his brother, Ben.

Keith is survived by his wife, Alyce of Spokane Valley, Washington; his daughter, Teresa (Dave) Stephens and their children Nathan (Carley) Stephens, Nichole Stephens, Jacob Stephens and Melissa Stephens all of Spokane Valley, Washington; his son, Steven (Lona) Warrenburg of Billings, Montana and their children Ashly Warrenburg of Glendive, Montana, Erin Warrenburg of Great Falls, Montana and Emily Warrenburg of Billings, Montana; six great grandchildren, Riley, Brody, Koby, Taevyn, Griffin and Boston; and numerous nieces, nephews, relatives and friends.
