GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Samuel A. Zeimer, age 87, passed away on Thursday, September 17, 2009 at the Glendive Medical Center. cars. Sam's favorite thing to do was spend time with his children and grandchildren. Sam was a member of the American Legion and the North American Hunting Club. Sam was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Dorothy in 2007; an infant daughter, Lilly, his daughter, Laura Peyatt; two sisters, Judy and Mary and one brother, Steven.
