March 30, 1946 - July 3, 2024

Sandra W. (Dew) Snow, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and friend, passed away on July 3, 2024, at the age of 78. She was born on March 30, 1946, in Rock Springs, Wyoming, to Thomas (Bill) and Anna Dew.

Sandra's early years were spent amidst the beauty of the upper Green River Valley, where her parents owned the Black Butte Ranch. She attended Black Butte rural grade school before moving to Rock Springs, where she completed her grammar school education under the care of her grandparents, Finis and Emma Mitchell. Sandra later graduated with honors from high school in Pinedale, Wyoming, in 1964.

Following her passion for education and literature, Sandra attended Rocky Mountain College in Billings, Montana, where she graduated cum laude with a BA in English in 1967. During this time, she married Dennis Snow on June 4, 1966, in Rock Springs, Wyoming. To this union a daughter Daphne Jill was born on October 24th, 1967, and the adoption of son Darren Jon on April 19th, 1970.

Sandra's career in education began in Conrad, Montana, where she taught at a country school. She later taught at Deer Creek School in Glendive, Montana, and served as a substitute teacher in the Glendive Public School System for many years, positively impacting the lives of numerous students. In 1972, Sandra and Dennis relocated to Glendive, Montana, where they established Gateway Vending, later renamed Blue Sky Incorporated in 1973 with the establishment of Blue Sky Ice. Dennis and Sandra's entrepreneurial

spirit led to the expansion of their business ventures, including Blue Sky Storage in 1996, and Blue Sky RV Park in 2018.

Beyond her professional accomplishments, Sandra was known for her love of bridge, teaching many the intricacies of the game. She was also an avid sewer, finding great joy and purpose in quilting alongside her quilting friend Ruby Wood. Sandra generously donated many of her quilts to family, friends, and charitable causes.

Sandra was preceded in death by her parents, Thomas and Anna Dew, and her beloved daughter, Daphne Jill Snow. She is survived by her devoted husband, Dennis Snow; loving son, Darren Snow; cherished grandchildren, Craig Jimison-Snow, Jacob (Snow) Meyers, Alexis Snow, and Reece Snow; and her beloved companion dog, Snickers.

A graveside service celebrating Sandra's life will be held at 10:30 AM on Friday, July 12, 2024 in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive, Montana with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. 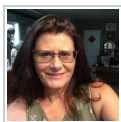
