Scott David Dietz, age 53, of Beach, North Dakota, formerly of Nekoma, North Dakota, went to be with his Lord on Sunday, February 24, 2008. He died at the St. Joseph's Hospital in Dickinson, North Dakota, after fighting a courageous battle with cancer. He entered the United States Army in December of 1973 and was honorably discharged in December of 1976. Scott was united in marriage to Judy Verwey on April 12, 1975, in Nekoma. Following their marriage, the couple lived in Nekoma where they farmed and raised cattle. In 1981, the family moved to Beach, North Dakota, where he was employed by the North Dakota Highway Patrol. Scott enjoyed the outdoors, especially hunting and fishing. He loved to read and take pictures. He enjoyed his Saturday morning visits with his mother Jean on the telephone. His greatest enjoyment in life was spending time with his family

and playing with his grand-dogs, Cassie and Dozer. Scott will be greatly missed by those who loved him. Scott was preceded in death by his father, Robert Dietz; his maternal grandparents; his paternal grandparents; his mother-in-law, LeNora Verwey; and his niece, Tawnya Roppel.
