



Selma "Sally" Frisinger

October 13, 1921 - September 29, 2005

Selma E. "Sally" Frisinger, a friend, confidant, and counselor to all generations, left her pain and suffering behind and went on to reside with her loving Savior. Funeral services will be held at 3:00 P.M., Thursday, September 29, 2005, at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Sally was born between Richey and Bloomfield to Mennonite pioneers, Erhart and Lena (Albrecht) Senner on October 13, 1921. She attended rural schools, although in the beginning she was asked to return home until she could add English to her already fluent German. She graduated from Richey High School in 1941 and went on to graduate from Montana State with a diploma in nursing. Sally began her never ending nursing career with the former NP Hospital in Glendive. It was here she met, via a blind date, a handsome WWII veteran, Abraham Frisinger of Wibaux. They were married in 1947 and moved to Retah Table to farm. Our house became a medical first aide station, whether it was broken bones or allergic reactions, Mom gave advice and treatments. We couldn't go home after church until Mom had made her rounds with blood pressure cuff in hand. Mom loved being a farmer and she preferred working in the soil to the more mundane house chores. After the move to Glendive she continued "farming" in her garden. In her later years, when bending over was made impossible by a back brace, it was not uncommon to see her lying next to the flower beds,

weeding. Most of all, our mother touched many lives through her friendship, listening ear, or simple acceptance. Whether with a crowd of teenagers meeting at her house for a noon chicken dinner, or a person with deafness, feeling isolated and needing companionship, Mom was there. Mom's life was filled with faith in her Lord and Savior. She regularly attended church services, belonged to LWML groups and enjoyed Bible studies. Mom also taught Sunday School for many years. She was amazed by God's grace in the forgiveness of her sins. After these last years of medical battles, fought and many won, she is now at peace with Christ. She was preceded in death by her husband, Abe in 2001 and her parents. She is survived by her children: sons; Mark (Karyl) of Richey, Guy (Sandy) of Helena and daughter; Karen (John) Pickart of Glendive; her brother, Delmer (Faye) Senner of Glendive. She also leaves the joys of her life, her grands and great grands: Jess (Amy), Amanda and Emily Frisinger of Richey, Josh (Sage), Jori, Cali and Tel Frisinger of Bozeman, Jenell Pickart of LaMoure, North Dakota, Susan Pickart of Bismarck, North Dakota, Tanya Frisinger of Bozeman, Jeremy Frisinger of Helena and Jessica, Alyssa and Amber Frisinger of Helena.
