Sheryl “Sherry” Ann Weaver, age 66 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Wednesday, February 5, 2025 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana. Funeral services will be at 10:00 AM on Monday, February 17, 2025 at the Glendive Evangelical Church with Pastor David Steinbron officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Sherry was born on September 15, 1958 in Glendive to her parents Richard “Dick” and Mabel (Elmquist) Kaul. She was raised and educated in Glendive graduating from Dawson County High School with the class of 1977. Following her education, she was united in marriage to her high school sweetheart, Darwin Rilley in June of 1979 and to this union three children were born. The family resided in Billings, Montana until 1987 when they moved to California until 1991 when they returned to Glendive. This marriage ended and Sherry then met John Weaver. They were married in 2004 until John passed away in 2013. Sherry worked at various jobs during her time with us. She started when her kids were young by creating jewelry or crafts in their living room, her first business lovingly called Buttons N Beads, and selling them at craft shows. She enjoyed working at Albertons where she was able to work with her son Casey for several years. She was an active person who loved going on walks all around town where many people would see her whether it was rainy or the sun was shining, ensuring that her pockets were filled with dog treats for the fur friends she would encounter along her way.

With the support and help of her parents Sherry bought Vivian's Hobby Shop and started her own business Trinkets and Treasures in 1999. Her Dad Richard would come in daily to help with the shop and visit with their patrons where he worked so diligently as though it were his own business. Often Sherry would be out and about town looking for small or large items that she cherished, deciding whether or not she would keep them for herself or sell them in her store for others to enjoy. The store, in many ways, is her life. There are glimmers of her personality in every inch and every item around. Sherry enjoyed her customers, many of whom would come in regularly. Sherry owned and operated Trinkets and Treasures until 2017 when her health forced her to retire. You could find her either at her shop or during her frequent daily trips to The Attic, where her creative mind saw potential in everything she saw. She had an eye for antiques of all shapes and sizes with an artistic streak that ran deep and made its way into the world through drawings, handmade crafts or a refurbished piece of furniture. She had a sweet and nurturing side for animals and had a special love for her babies (kitties). She passed her love of cats along to her daughter Misty. Her boys delighted in making her laugh and made it their mission to get a reaction out of her as often as they could.

Sherry lived a quiet and simple life and later due to health concerns moved into the Wibaux County nursing home in 2020 and resided there until her passing.

She was preceded in death by her parents Richard and Mabel; her husband John Weaver and her brother-in-law Les Snovelle, and her first husband Darwin.

Sherry is survived by her children, Cory (Rebel) Rilley of Bigfork, Montana, Casey (Desirae) Rilley of Glendive and Misty Rilley of Billings; four grandchildren, Emily Rilley, Jentry Rilley, Kohen Rilley, Kennedy Rilley and one sister, Janet Snovelle of Helen, Montana, niece Angee Steir of Great Falls, Montana.
