Sheryn Ann Gackle, 78, of Brockway, MT, passed away on Friday, December 5, 2025, at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive, MT. A Memorial Service will be held at 11:00 AM on Friday, June 19, 2026, at the First Lutheran Church in Circle, MT with Pastor Jacque VanDenburg officiating. Interment will follow in the Riverview Cemetery in Circle. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

She was born June 5th, 1947 to Alden "Beans" and Katie Mae Bergland in Glendive, MT. Sheryn grew up in Circle and was a constant "customer" along with her buddies @ Chapin Drug. She later welcomed younger brother Rocky. Both became drug store cowboys along with all the kids of Circle. Lots of summer days were spent out @ the Schillinger farm playing with her cousins and several times she would travel to Spokane Washington on the train to stay with her Aunt Muriel Olson. She attended both grade and high school at Circle, graduating from the CHS golden class of 1965. It was during that time she met Del and lifelong friendship began. After high school, Sheryn attended MSU Bozeman pursuing a degree in nursing. She and her good friend Sharon Idland (Woodward) would later spend time doing floor work at Billings Deaconess. What a pair...what a good time.

In 1969 she and Del were married and moved to Santa Barbara, CA where Del finished his schooling. Sheryn worked as an RN for Santa Barbara

Cottage Hospital during that time.

They moved back to the Brockway area in 1973 and bought the family farm. In the years following, their daughter, Robin was born into the family and a while later son, Darrell. There were so many fun times at Christmas, Thanksgiving and Easter spent with friends and relatives the last several decades. She was also a great cook and gardener. Her sweet dough buns were the best and there were always favorite recipes that had to be done just right. In the garden, she would insist on only 3 tomato plants. That meant only 3 varieties which days later turned into 15 plants. For entertainment, NFL football Nascar, college softball and gymnastics were always her favorites.

She also worked at the McCone County nursing home for a period of years as an RN. During times when Beans and Katie were gone, she helped run the Drug Store with Irene Wilhelm. Consequently, Robin and Darrell also spent lots of time near the soda fountain and were almost always rearranging the toys in the basement.

Sheryn was preceded in death by her parents Beans and Katie Bergland, her father and mother in-law, Oscar and Annetta Gackle, brother in-law, Duane (Irene) Gackle and sister in-law Gloria (Junior) Lala.

She is survived by her husband, Del, daughter Robin (Mike) Kirby, grandson Caiden Kirby, granddaughter Shiyon Kirby, son Darrell, brother Rocky (Debbie) Bergland, brother in-law Junior Lala (Donna), sister in-law Irene Gackle, plus several nephews, nieces and cousins.
