Stanley Michael Dobrowski, age 98, passed away Saturday, January 28, 2006 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive, Montana. A Vigil service will be held 6:30 P.M., Wednesday, February 1, 2006 in the St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux. Mass of Christian Burial will be held 10:00 A.M., Thursday, February 2, 2006 at St. Philip's Catholic Church in St. Philip, Montana with Father Denis Fournier officiating. He was preceded in death by three brothers, John, Edmund, Allie; two sisters, Mary Keller and Rose Burling and one daughter, Leona.
