



## Ted Lawrence Hogan

January 2, 1930 - April 23, 2004

Ted Lawrence Hogan, age 74, of Glendive and formerly of Long Beach, California, passed away on Wednesday, April 21, 2004 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Graveside services with military honors were held on Friday, April 23, 2004 at the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive was entrusted with arrangements. Ted was born on January 2, 1930 in Albuquerque, New Mexico, the son of William F. and Marguerite M. (Creswick) Hogan. Ted lived most of his life in Long Beach, with a short time in Missouri prior to moving to Wolf Point in 1995 and then into the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in 2000. Mr. Hogan served in the U.S. Army from 1954 until 1960, spending three years in Germany. Upon his discharge, he was a commercial driver, and then became a sporting goods store owner along with becoming co-owner/bartender of three bars in the Long Beach area with his brother. Ted became the everyday "Santa Claus" at Eastern Montana Veterans Home, with his trimmed white beard and jolly laughter. He always had a twinkle in his eye and a smile for everyone. He loved to smoke his pipe and have his daily shot of Christian Brothers Brandy. He loved to play cards, watch sci-fi movies and he read ferociously everything that he could. He will be greatly missed. Survivors include his son, Michael Hogan and his daughter, Kelly Hogan.
