Glendive, Montana: Terry Allen Coon passed away September 30th, 2012 of a heart attack at his home in Glendive. Terry was born in Lewistown, Montana on February 10, 1948, to Lee and Marjorie (Sandaker) Coon. He grew up in Washington, Wyoming and many places in Montana including Winnett, Billings, Roundup, Wolf Point and Glendive. He spent many summers in Winnett with his Uncle Allen and grandparents, Tillman and Hazel Sandaker. He enjoyed baseball; varsity basketball and varsity track and graduated from Wolf Point High School with the class of 1966. After high school he attended Northern Montana College in Havre, Montana to study diesel mechanics. In 1967, he married Rynette Nina Ingebretson and in 1969 they moved to Glendive to start a long trucking career working with his dad hauling petroleum products. He went into business for himself in 1974 and continued hauling petroleum products throughout eastern Montana and western North Dakota until his death. His various trucks became part of the

family throughout the years and they were always detailed with his trucking logos. Terry and Rynette's daughter, Tara, was born in 1971 and their son, Rhett in 1974. Terry was always involved in his children's activities. He coached Little League Baseball, was an assistant Babe Ruth coach and drove the bus for Legion baseball. He served as the Chairman of the Deer Creek School Board and as Vice Chairman on the Dawson County High School Board for a cumulative service of twenty years. He was able to hand both of his children their high school diplomas at their Dawson County High School graduation ceremonies. Terry will be remembered through his trucks and his sense of humor. It didn't matter if he knew you or not--he loved to joke around. Although he spent many hours driving truck, he always found time to attend his grandchildren's events. He talked to them almost daily and enjoyed them immensely. His four grandchildren are Taven Diesel and Ramey Erin Coon, Chantz William and Blayne Allen Hubing. He was preceded in death by his parents, Lee Eugene and Marjorie Evelyn (Sandaker) Coon; and brother, James Eugene Coon. He is survived by his wife, Rynette Coon of Glendive; his daughter, Tara (Jon) Hubing of Circle, Montana and Rhett (Tiffany) Coon of Glendive. He is also survived by a brother, Larry (Becky) Coon of Glendive; sisters, Linda (Duane) Sibley of Nashua, Montana and Judy (Brant) Nordwick of Shoshoni, Wyoming and many nieces, nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews.
