Thomas Allen Kurtz, age 57, of Glendive, passed away on Wednesday, April 4, 2007 at his home in Glendive. Tom continued to work as a truck driver in the oilfields while operating his own business, Tom's Oilfield Service. He also worked for Eiker Inc and was working for D & M Water Service at the time of his death. Tom was preceded in death by his father, Orville. Survivors include his wife, Gwen, of Glendive; his son, Shawn Kurtz and his wife Allison of Bozeman, Montana; his daughter, Shannon Crowe and her husband Shane of
