



## Thomas C. "T.J." Adams

Thomas C. "T.J." Adams, age 78, of Glendive, passed away on Wednesday, October 5, 2005 at the Glendive Medical Center. Tom was preceded in death by his parents; his brother, Boyce Washington Adams and his grandson, Jeremy Nimmick.
