



## Tim Egeness

May 9, 1946 - November 21, 2023

Tim A. Egeness, age 77 of Glendive, Montana, passed away on Tuesday, November 21, 2023 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. A Graveside service with military honors will be held at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, November 29, 2023 in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Tim was born on May 9, 1946 in Glendive to his parents Theodore and Marie (Gonshorowski) Egeness. He was raised in Glendive, and attended Egeness School North of Lindsday, Montana, until high school. Tim graduated from Dawson County High School with the class of 1964. Following high school, he went to Washington and built fence with his brothers. Tim returned to Glendive and married Charlotte Post on August 9, 1965. To this union, three children were born. Three months after they were married, Tim was drafted into the U.S. Army. He served for 2 years, and spent 1 year in Vietnam until his Honorable Discharge. Tim returned to Glendive and worked construction for a few years until he started his career with the City of Glendive. He retired from the city in 2007, but continued to do small engine repair for a while.

Tim enjoyed fishing and camping when the kids were younger. He also liked feeding the stray neighborhood cats. Tim was a quiet man, and kept to himself.

He was preceded in death by his parents, 2 brothers Wesley and Bud Egeness, and 2 sisters Carol Egeness and Marie Lovaas.

Tim is survived by his wife Charlotte of Glendive; his children Christina

Egeness (Steve Yuran) of Glendive, Cynthia Egeness of Dickinson, North Dakota, and Cory (DeAndra) Egeness of Billings, Montana; 3 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.
