



## Timothy L. Shearer

Timothy L. Shearer, age 78, of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, May 16, 2004 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 A.M., Thursday, May 20, 2004 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson and Pastor Paul Everett officiating. Tim was born on October 21, 1925 in Glendive, Montana, the son of Homer "Dick" and Agnes (Bren) Shearer. He attended school in the Lindsay area and Glendive. Tim farmed with his mother until 1955 when he entered the U.S. Army. He served until his discharge in 1957. He married Esther Hanson on June 13, 1959 at Washburn, North Dakota. Following their marriage, Tim was employed as a ranch hand at the Dillon Ranch, located southwest of Lindsay until 1964 when they moved to Glendive where Tim was caretaker of the Dawson County Fairgrounds for nine years. He also drove school bus for several years. Tim and his wife moved to their present home in Glendive in 1973. He worked for the U.S. Postal Service for over 25 years, retiring in 1990. Tim was a member of Zion Lutheran Church and served as custodian for several years. He enjoyed gardening, flowers, exhibiting items at the fair and the outdoors. He also enjoyed volunteering, visiting, and attending activities at the Senior Citizen's Center. Tim was preceded in death by his parents and his grandparents, Frank and Anna Bren.
