



Timothy "Tim" J. Marman

January 16, 1949 - May 31, 2022

Timothy "Tim" J. Marman, 73, of Beach, North Dakota passed away on May 31, 2022. Tim was born on January 16, 1949, fifteen minutes before his brother, Thomas "Tom" J. Marman, to Donald "Don" and Mary Helen (Niece) Marman in Beach. After graduating from Beach High School in 1967, he went on to play football at North Dakota State University (NDSU) in Fargo with Tom, where they went on to win two National Championships and were inducted into the NDSU Football Hall of Fame. After graduation, Tim was drafted into the United States Army, where he served as a medic for two years in Germany. After serving, he returned to Fargo for one year where he was a Graduate Assistant Coach for the NDSU Bison. He then came home to Beach and joined the family business, Marman Plumbing and General Construction. In 1975, he married Linda Erickstad, and they went on to have three children: Luke, Jessica, and Joshua.

Tim was a valued member of his community. He was elected as Councilman to the City of Beach, a position he proudly held for 17 years. He also served on the Golden Valley County Zoning Board for 13 years, and as a volunteer fireman for over 10 years. One of Tim's greatest passions was the City of Beach. He loved his hometown, and his dedication was evident to all who knew him.

Tim could usually be found with his twin brother, Tom. These two have been known to be forces of nature, always working hard, and determined to provide for their respective families and community. Tim also enjoyed golf, and could

often be found golfing when he wasn't working or serving his community. Tim is survived by his children, Luke (Maria) Marman, Jessica Bunk, and Joshua (Angelina) Marman; his grandchildren, Lydia Marman, Clara Marman, and one grandchild on the way; his brothers, Dan (Meg) Marman, Tom (Sue) Marman, Gerry (Linda) Marman, and Dick (Krystyna) Marman; and many nieces and nephews. He will also be missed by Aussie, his beloved dog. Tim was predeceased by his mother, Mary Helen, in 2005, and his father, Don, in 2006.
