Timothy Wayne Wentz, age 40, of Glendive, died on Monday, July 25, 2005 at his home in Glendive. Centers and Pool. Tim loved to experience life. He enjoyed traveling and checking out local museums and historical landmarks. His infectious sense of humor insured that he never met a person that didn't like him and he tried to find the silver lining to every situation. Tim was well known for his support of the Green Bay Packers and Nascar's Jeff Gordon - especially when Gordon beat Earnhardt, Jr. He collected Coca-Cola memorabilia and rarely drank anything else.
