



Todd A. Leach

February 2, 1961 - May 26, 2021

Todd Anthony Leach, 60, son, husband, father, uncle, brother, and loyal friend passed away on Wednesday, May 26, 2021 in Wibaux, Montana after his two year battle with cancer. Visitation will be from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM on Tuesday, June 1, 2021 at the Silha Funeral Home in Wibaux. Funeral services will be at 3:00 PM on Wednesday, June 2, 2021 at the Wibaux High School Gymnasium with Pastor Roger Dieterle officiating. Interment will be in the Wibaux Cemetery. Silha Funeral Home of Wibaux has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Todd was born on February 2, 1961 in Williston, North Dakota to Arthur and Muriel (Heen) Leach. Todd grew up in Ray, North Dakota where he loved spending time on the farm with his Grandpa Lars. When Todd was in the fifth grade he moved to Wibaux, Montana, which would become his home for the remainder of his life. In high school, he established himself as a prominent athlete in sports, especially track. In 1979, Todd placed third place as an individual at the divisional track meet. He set two school records at the meet, as he placed first in all five events he participated in, which included the 100 yard dash, triple jump, high jump, 220 yard dash, and the long jump. This performance would qualify Todd for the 1979 Class C state track meet, where he would go on to take 2nd place all by himself. Due to this accolade, some of his close friends referred to him as "The Legend."

After high school, Todd joined Goldenwest Electric as a lineman. He worked there for 30 years and retired in 2013. Throughout the years, he took on many construction jobs and helped build several homes and buildings within the Wibaux area. In 2003, Todd joined Brian Nelson and Bill Franks to bring a grocery store back to Wibaux. One year later, in 2004, Todd finished building the Corner Market and together their idea that was once a dream became reality. In addition to the grocery store, he also constructed the building known as the Wibaux Fire Department.

Todd and Jeff Robert's passion for working out brought a gym to small town Wibaux, MT. This love for fitness impacted multiple generations of Wibaux athletes, which continues today. Recently, he left his mark on this gym by renovating everything and adding new equipment.

In 1986, Amy McCann came back to teach at Wibaux Elementary School. Todd's interest in Amy grew and the chase was on. On June 26, 1993, they were married in Glendive, Montana. On January 10, 1996, Chelsea Rose Leach was born. She was the apple of his eye. Shortly after, Conner Anthony Leach was born on July 8, 1997. He was dad's little sidekick. He loved attending their sporting events. His happiest days were when Ty asked for his daughter's hand in marriage and the day Conner was able to take him for their first flight together above Wibaux.

Additionally, Todd had a strong desire to help others throughout the community. He would drop everything he was doing to help anyone who needed an extra hand. He loved spending time with family and friends, playing cornhole, hanging out at Buffalo Wild Wings, and especially going to Table Rock Lake. Todd was often referred to as "The Dog Whisperer". His favorites were Rascal, Gus, Bean, and granddog Kimber.

Todd is preceded in death by his brothers, Kevin Leach and Kim Leach; his

father, Arthur Fulton Leach, and one of his best friends Mike Roberts.

Todd is survived by his wife of 27 years, Amy Leach, his daughter, Chelsea (Ty) Tousignant, his son, Conner Leach, his mother, Muriel Leach, his sister, Tracey Sunwall, his nieces, nephews, cousins, and Aunt Nina.

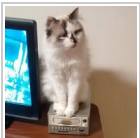
