GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Thomas D. "Tom" Boje, 72, passed away at his home on Friday, May 15, 2009. He went on to work at Tomalino's Radio and TV, Kampschror's, and Al's Auto Sales before owning and operating Alken Motors until 1984 and later retiring from HKT Motors in 2005. Tom was the most loving husband, father, grandfather and friend. His four daughters thought of him as their teddy bear who was always there for them. He still managed to stay patient and kind even though there

were five women in the house and one bathroom. He dearly loved his daughters and enjoyed bringing them unique modes of transportation that he took in on trade. Tom's grandchildren were his pride and joy. His grandkids will always have their precious memories of special times with grandpa. Tom believed in his country and was honored to show his patriotism. He was proud of his service in the Army reserves and received an honorable discharge in 1965. Tom was always on the go and kept busy. He kept the busiest completing his daughters' to-do lists and building Kelli's houses. In his spare time, he enjoyed boating with the family at the lake or reminiscing at the family farm.
