November 5, 1918 - January 25, 2003

Valentine "Val" Pfau Jr., age 84, of Glendive, passed away on Friday, January 17, 2003 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility in Glendive. Memorial mass will be held at 2:00 P.M., Saturday, January 25, 2003 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Val was born on November 5, 1918 in Richardton, North Dakota, the son of Valentine Sr. and Eva (Messer) Pfau. He was raised and educated in Richardton. He was later employed as a heavy equipment operator for Stark County, North Dakota for over 20 years before moving to Glendive where he worked in the maintenance department at Jefferson School until his retirement.
