This project provided homemade quilts for end-of-life patients to comfort them in nursing homes and hospitals in the

surrounding area. Valerie was a member of the Women of Mott Organization. She especially loved to be with and around her family. One of Valerie's most precious gift's was the gift of life through organ donation. Valerie was preceded in death by: Lynn and Helen Chaska, maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Ovila Rheault, fraternal foster grandparents, and Shirley Christianson Greenwood, fraternal grandmother. Valerie is survived by her parents, Wayne A. and Carol A.
