May 29, 1918 - December 4, 2008

GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Vern C. Buller, age 90, of Glendive, Montana passed away on Saturday, November 29, 2008 at the Glendive Medical Center, in Glendive. Visitation will be held from 10:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. Wednesday, December 3, 2008 at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M. Thursday, December 4, 2008 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Pastors Neville Peterson and Willis Busnitz will be officiating. Interment will be at 1:30 P.M. on Thursday, December 4, 2008, in the Bethlehem Mennonite Cemetery in Bloomfield, Montana. Vern was born on May 29, 1918 the son of Isaac and Yettie (Boese) Buller at his grandparents homestead near Richey, Montana. Vern was raised and educated in the Richey area. Vern and Violet (Richert) were married on December 28, 1941 at the Bethlehem Mennonite Church. They farmed there until 1954, they then moved to Paraguay where Vern helped clear land and build roads. In 1956 they moved back to Richey. Vern returned to farming and also worked construction. 1960 had them living back in Paraguay while Vern developed a rice plantation. In 1965 the call to return to the Richey area brought them back, so Vern could continue farming, he also drove truck and moved houses. In the late 1980's they moved to Lame Deer, Montana, Vern helped to build the Lame Deer Mennonite Church. He was very involved with the bible camps that were held there. The title of "Resident Handyman" came

natural to him because there wasn't anything he couldn't fix or operate. Vern and Violet moved to Glendive in 2005 and have resided since. Vern loved God. He felt God's calling for him was to be an inspiration and a servant to others, which he did with love and compassion. He especially loved his children, his grandchildren and his great-grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his parents, three brothers and one infant granddaughter. Vern is survived by his wife Violet of Glendive, son Tom (Linda) Buller of Glendive, daughter, Kathy (Doug) Gadowski of Albuquerque, New Mexico, daughter Nina Mosier of Republic, Ohio, daughter Cecilia Jenkins of Albuquerque, two sisters, Gladys Goosen of Billings, Montana, Margie Unruh of Glendive, one brother, Marlo Buller of Richey, six grandchildren, 8 great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
